This email is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request dated March 26, 2021.

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter, 5 ILCS 140/9(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filling a Request for Review with the PAC.
